(A guide to how to get wheels at Allegheny)

For Allegheny Related Use:

Motor Pool

The use of College vehicles from Motor Pool (at the individual's or organization's expense) is allowed only when authorized for official college business, **with employee approval**.

- Organization Activities
- Conference Attendance

Costs for motor pool vehicles are as follows:

- 15 Passenger Van - \$10/day or \$0.75/mile, whichever is greater
- 12 Passenger \$10/day or \$0.75/mile
- Minivan - \$10/day or \$0.65/mile, whichever is greater
- Cars - \$10/day or \$0.50/mile, whichever is greater

Community Service Vans

The use of vans from Community Service is limited to community service projects that are approved by the Office of Community Service. These vans are offered on a first-come, first-serve basis, and are reserved by completing a form at the Office of Community Service in Reis Hall.

Costs:

- There is no cost for local community service.
- Drivers must have a Gator License

ASG Van

The ASG van may be used by any member of the Allegheny College community for official college business/activities. Priority will be given to student organizations. All drivers must have a Gator License granted by the Office of Safety & Security. The driver must abide by all College motor pool policies, as well as ASG Van policies. Policies can be found at the ASG Office or on the ASG website.

- **Cost:** The vehicle must be returned with a full tank of gas. Monetary penalties for not returning the van without a full tank of gas, late, or with garbage left may be applied.
