

Vaccination Requirements at Allegheny College

Allegheny requires basic up-to-date childhood vaccinations at the time of matriculation. Specifically, these are:

- Completion of the primary tetanus-diphtheria series, and a booster within the past ten years
- Two MMR vaccinations, the first must be after the age of 12 months, and the second at 4 years of age or older
- A tuberculosis PPD Mantoux skin test within the past year
- Completion of childhood the polio series
- Hepatitis B vaccinations, either a standard 3 dose or 2 dose regimen
- A current meningitis vaccine

There are other series of vaccines that are recommended, but not required.

All injections are required prior to matriculation. Sanctions are in place to encourage students to comply with these requirements, as these vaccinations help protect our community. These sanctions include invalidation of student IDs, and holding of room keys. In the event that a new student has difficulty obtaining any of the vaccinations, every effort is made to assist the student in meeting the vaccination requirements.
