

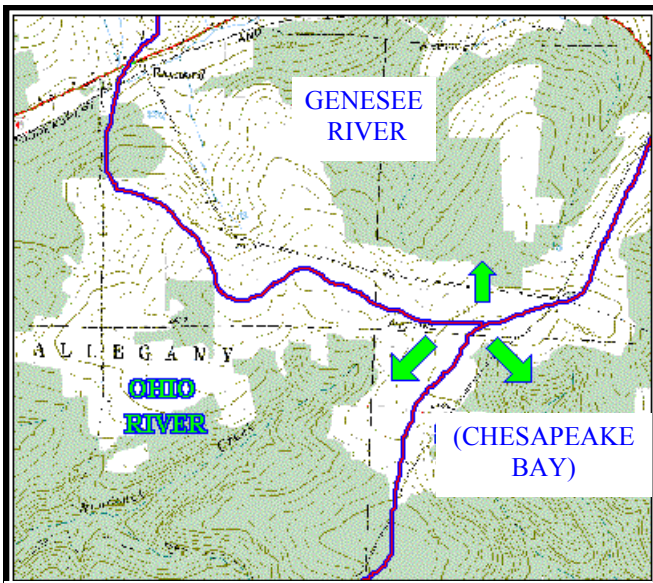


## Visual Resource : ONE HILLTOP, THREE MAJOR WATERSHEDS!



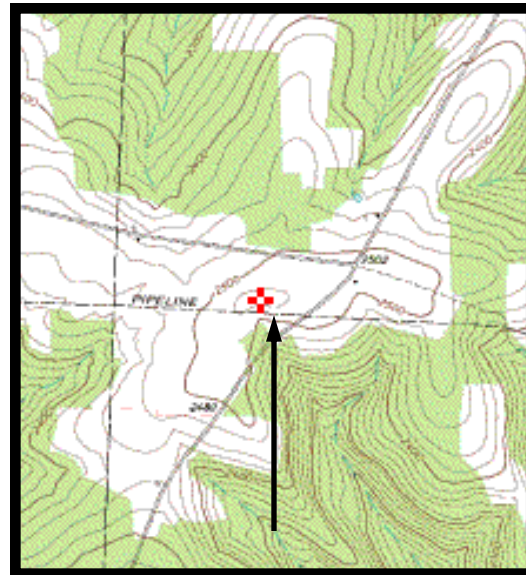
**Figure 3.** This unnamed, nondescript hilltop in Potter County, Pennsylvania is the only hilltop from which runoff drains into three different major PA watersheds (the Genesee River, the Susquehanna River/Chesapeake Bay, and the Ohio River) of the six total major PA watersheds (the Genesee River, the Susquehanna River/Chesapeake Bay, the Ohio River, the Potomac River, Lake Erie, and the Delaware River).

**Figure 4.** The hilltop in Potter County that drains into three different major Pennsylvania watersheds.

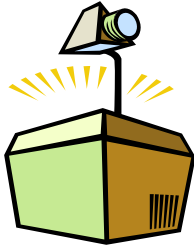

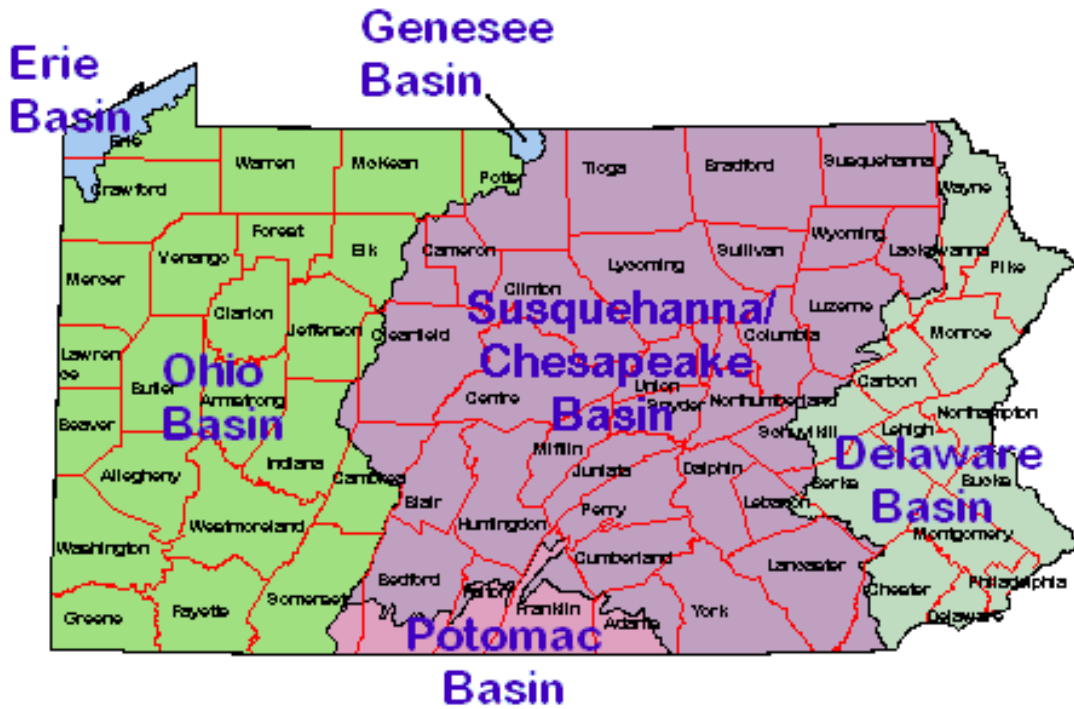


Figure 1. Pennsylvania's six major watersheds.
