- The Allegheny College Global Health Program is offering funding for a limited number of students who identify off-campus research sites *with mentors willing to supervise their summer research projects*.
- Students may engage in a project that focuses on any of the multiple determinants of health and could include research at domestic or international health organizations, research universities, or NGOs. - For this summer research experience, the hourly rate will be \$10/hour for up to 35 hours/week and 10 weeks for a total of \$3,500. In addition, transportation and/or housing costs of up to \$1,500 may be requested.

 March 28th, 2017 in order to be considered for funding. Awards will be competitively selected.

Instructions:

- 1) Fill out the pdf form linked here and save
- 2) Attach a typed 1-2 page description of your proposed project including:
 - a) a brief description of the project
 - b) your role in the project during the summer
 - c) a short description of how this summer research experience will contribute to your personal or professional development
 - d) a short description of how this summer research experience relates, or will relate, to your coursework in the Global Health Studies major or minor.

- 3) By March 28th, 2017 have your off-campus research mentor send an email to Lee Coates locates@allegheny.edu indicating that he or she has talked to you about suitable summer research projects and is willing to mentor you during the summer research experience.
- 4) Have an Allegheny faculty member send a letter of recommendation supporting your application for these research funds to Lee Coates Box 10 or send email to lcoates@allegheny.edu.
