

Summer Research Opportunities

Allegheny College Global Health Program

The Allegheny College Global Health Program is pleased to announce funding opportunities for a limited number of student research internships, both on- and off-campus, during the summer of 2017. Summer research internships will be funded by a grant to Allegheny College from the Howard Hughes Medical Institute. Students chosen to receive this funding will be selected based on their qualifications, letters of support, potential for personal and professional development, and the significance of the proposed project to global health.

Summer Research at Off-Campus Sites

We are able to offer funding for students who identify off-campus research sites with mentors who are willing to supervise their summer research projects. Projects could be related to any of the multiple determinants of health (e.g. biology, economics, environment, culture, and politics), so students from any discipline or major are welcome to apply. Research sites could include domestic or international health organizations, research universities, or related government agencies.

For this summer research experience, the hourly rate will be \$10/hour for up to 35 hours/week and 10 weeks for a total of \$3,500. In addition, transportation and/or housing costs of up to \$1,500 may be requested. The deadline for applying for funding for off-campus summer research is **Tuesday, March 28th, 2017**. Summer Research with Allegheny Faculty

For on-campus research internships, students should coordinate with Allegheny faculty that have projects focused on an aspect of Global Health. As stated above, projects could be related to any of the multiple determinants of health (e.g. biology, economics, environment, culture, and politics), so students from any discipline or major are welcome to apply.

For this summer research experience, the hourly rate will be \$10/hour for up to 35 hours/week and 10 weeks for a total of \$3,500. Room and board will be provided, although students will have to pay a small tax per week on the value of the room.
