

“Tour of Historic Holland Hall, former Huidekoper Mansion”



Join the **History Department** faculty for a tour of Holland Hall, former Huidekoper Mansion. This Hall was built in 1899 for Arthur Clarke and Frances Reynolds Huidekoper, daughter of the Baldwin-Reynolds House Museum's William and Julia Reynolds. Dutch Revival in inspiration, the home served the family until the 1930s when, after the owners passed away, their children moved to Conneaut Lake and deeded it to Allegheny College. It served as the Phi Delta Theta House for many years, and now, after a period of private ownership, work is underway to return it to its former beauty.
